The elective component of the educational and professional program consists

- non-specialist disciplines (MINOR COURSE, ELECTIVE COURSES);

- professional discipline (MAJOR COURSE, ELECTIVE COURSES).

Non-specialist disciplines (MINOR COURSE, ELECTIVE COURSES) are chosen by students from the general list of academic disciplines of the University (pool of selective disciplines of S. Kuznets Khnev National University).

ELECTIVE COURSES – separate variable disciplines totaling 5 ECTS credits. For the general cycle, such disciplines can be:

- disciplines of social and humanitarian orientation (for example: "Sociology", "Political science", "Psychology", "Rhetoric", others);

- disciplines of technological orientation (for example: "Concepts of modern

natural science", "Systems of industrial technologies", "Basics of ecology", others)

- legal disciplines (for example: "Economic Law", "Labour Law", "Civil Law", etc.).

MINOR COURSE – this is a block of four interrelated disciplines of a noncore for the student training direction, which are studied consecutively in 2, 3 courses. The total volume of the MINOR COURSE is 20 ECTS credits (5 credits per discipline).

Professional courses (MAJOR COURSE, ELECTIVE COURSES) are offered by graduate departments. Collectively, MAJOR COURSE determines the specialization of training and can be offered as a package of educational disciplines.

РЕЦЕНЗІЯ-ВІДГУК

на освітньо-професійну програму «Міжнародний бізнес» галузі знань 29 «Міжнародні відносини» спеціальності 292 «Міжнародні економічні відносини» за першим (бакалаврським) рівнем

Забезпечення підготовки висококваліфікованих фахівців з міжнародних економічних відносин, які мають необхідні фундаментальні і практичні знання у сфері міжнародного бізнесу є важливим і актуальним завданням для розвитку економіки України та її інтеграції у світовий економічний простір. Для Харківського регіону така підготовка має особливе значення, тому що однією з провідних газузей є машинобудування. Для даної галузі дуже важливо є налагодження міжнародних зв'язків, як зі східними країнами, так і з країнами Європейського Союзу. Такі економічні реалії вимагають підготовки фахівців, здатних налагоджувати міжнародні економічні зв'язки, активізувати пошук нових ринків, стимулювати альтернативні напрями розвитку економіки регіону. Торговельний потенціал Сполучених Штатів Америки, Німеччини, Великої Британії, Франції, Японії, Канади не повністю українськими підприємствами. що є альтернативною використаний можливістю географічної диверсифікації експорту. В таких умовах має місце підвищений попит на кваліфікованих фахівців у сфері міжнародного бізнесу, що і створює інтерес до представленої на рецензування освітньо-професійної програми.

Освітньо-професійна програма «Міжнародний бізнес» галузі знань 29 «Міжнародні відносини» спеціальності 292 «Міжнародні економічні відносини» за першим (бакалаврським) рівнем розроблена проєктною групою кафедри міжнародних економічних відносин Харківського національного економічного університету імені Семена Кузнеця на основі узагальнення досвіду провідних підприємств регіону, які є потенційними роботодавцями. Виявлені тенденції ринку праці та особливості діяльності експорт- й імпорт-орієнтованих підприємств довели наявність потреби в підготовці фахівців-міжнародників, здатних розв'язувати спеціальні задачі та практичні проблеми з ефективного управління міжнародним бізнесом.

Запропоновані компоненти освітньо-професійної програми, їхня впорядкована структура та логічна послідовність дають можливість

здобувачам вищої освіти набути професійних компетентностей щодо інституційних, комунікаційних, аналітичних, організаційних та інших аспектів ведення міжнародного бізнесу. Під час проходження практики студенти можуть застосувати набуті компетентності, а потім удосконалювати їх у свої подальшій професійній діяльності.

Цикл професійної підготовки освітньо-професійної програми «Міжнародний бізнес» спрямований на опанування майбутніми фахівцями знань та оволодіння навичками щодо використання сучасних інформаційних технологій та математичних методів, засвоєння країнознавства, визначення особливостей організаційної поведінки міжнародних компаній, опанування зовнішньоекономічної діяльності, міжнародного маркетингу, міжнародного бізнесу та підприємництва. Також структура освітньо-професійної програми передбачає значну частину дисциплін вільного вибору, що дає змогу врахувати як інтереси студента, так і швидко реагувати на зміни і запити роботодавців.

Перелік компетентностей випускника освітньо-професійної програми «Міжнародний бізнес» забезпечує реалізацію важливих результатів навчання і враховує запити стейкхолдерів, що дає змогу досягти заявленої програмної мети з підготовки висококваліфікованих фахівців з міжнародних економічних відносин.

The educational and professional program "International Business" of the first (bachelor's) level of higher education in the specialty "International Economic Relations", which is reviewed, is aimed at training highly qualified specialists in international economic relations who have the necessary fundamental knowledge in the field of international business processes at the corporate level and possess competences and practical skills necessary for solving complex tasks and problems of effective management of international business.

A special feature of the educational and professional program is that the emphasis is placed on the study of international economic relations and the world economy; foreign economic activity of Ukraine and Kharkiv region; corporate forms and models of international business; mechanisms of organization, management, marketing of international business; financing, communication technologies and digital transformation of business processes in the system of international business; security-oriented development of small and medium-sized businesses on international markets.

The content and structure of the educational and professional program for applicants of the first (bachelor) level in the specialty 292 "International Economic Relations" is characterized by correspondence to the subject area of the specialty, systematic construction and logical sequence. The educational and professional program allows forming an individual educational trajectory by choosing selective educational components.

The peer-reviewed educational and professional program 292 International Economic Relations allows students to acquire competence in the field of solving complex problems related to professional activity in the field of international economic relations, namely the ability to manage international business, form, develop and implement strategies for personnel management of an international

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company, marketing, competitive, innovative, financial and other, taking into account the direction of activity of the subject of international business, taking into account the priorities of the start-specialization of the Kharkiv region. In addition, the applicants must demonstrate a number of learning outcomes, among which it is worth focusing on the ability to carry out a comprehensive analysis of complex economic systems, compare and compare their components, evaluate and argue for evaluations of the effectiveness of their functioning; apply the analytical toolkit for researching the state and prospects for the development of certain segments of the international markets of goods and services using modern knowledge about the methods, forms and tools of regulation of international trade.

All of the above shows that the peer-reviewed educational and professional program International Business for training students of higher education at the first (bachelor) level in the specialty 292 International Economic Relations is modern and relevant, ensures the formation of general and special (professional) competencies, program results and can be recommended for use.
